You are cordially invited to participate in the Old Settlers Day Parade June 27, 2008. The parade will start at 6:30 pm from the Columbia City High School. There is no cost for entry into the parade. Entrants must complete, sign and date the attached entry form. Forms are also available for download at <http://www.osdassociation.com/paradeform.htm>. The Parade line-up will post in the Columbia City Post & Mail the week of the Parade. Each entrant will have a colored section assignment. Inform check-in personnel at the White Flag marked entrance to the school of your assigned color section.

Parade line-up will begin at the Columbia City High School. All entries must check-in with personnel at the White Flag at the school entrance June 27, 2008 between the hours of 4:30 p.m. through 5:00 p.m.

Parade Rules:

- a. Entries consisting of person ('s) under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- b. Entries providing free items must walk along the curb and hand the items to the crowd. To promote spectator safety, do not throw items from moving units.
- c. Performing units should observe a 1-minute time limit in front of the Judge's Reviewing Stand.
- d. Entries should maintain reasonable speed to eliminate large gaps between entries.
- e. Commercial entries should limit their entry to one vehicle. Entries should be kept to a reasonable length; please no semi trucks.
- f. Animal entries must provide their own "Pooper Scoopers".

Prize Listing: Award presentation immediately following the parade at American Legion Post 98. Unclaimed awards are mailed to the party named on the entry form. Participating Color Guard Unit presenting to Post 98 immediately after the parade will receive a \$10.00 show-up fee.
